Then apply for license once all your paperwork is in order

You will be best to apply for: Sport / Target shooting, Category A & B. Recreational Hunting / Vermin Control Category A & B.

## How to:

- A MyServiceNSW Account (<u>www.service.nsw.gov.au</u>) linked to the NSW Police Force
- A copy of your firearms training and safety course certificate.
- Documented details of the address(s) where you'll safely store your firearms (if applicable)
- Documentations to support each genuine reason/category. (SSAA for this)
- A current credit card (Visa or Mastercard) for your payment, or
- A copy of your current eligible pensioner card. If Required.

In addition, depending on your genuine reason(s):

- If you're applying for a licence over and above a category A firearms licence, you need:
  - o Evidence that a 'special need' exists for a category B. (SSAA for this)
  - The reason(s) why the special need cannot be met by using another category of firearm.

Note: All documentation (certificates, documents, letters, licences, concession cards) must be in a digital format for uploading. Accepted file types are BMP, DOC, DOCX, JPG, PDF, PNG, TIF, XLS, XLSX with a 5MB size limit.

- Gather all your digital/scanned documentation, and have it ready for uploading. You cannot save and resume your application once you have started.
- Check you meet all the eligibility requirements.
- Select the 'Apply online' button.
- Log in, or create your MyServiceNSW Account at www.service.nsw.gov.au.
- Link to the NSW Police Force.
- Complete the online application form.
- Upload your supporting documentation.
- Enter your payment details (if requested).
- Read and confirm the declaration.
- Review and submit your application.
- Wait for paperwork to be mailed then out go to services NSW centre for photo etc.
